Regiment *1st & 3rd Mch* Brigade *Locksells* Army *Trenkles*

a resident of *Missouri*, and find him unable to perform
the duties of a soldier in the field, because of *Gun Shot Wound of*
Right Shoulder Joint Recured at the Battle
of Bountah and resulting in Ankylosis.

We furthermore declare this disability to be *Permanent* and
therefore recommend his *detail in Guard duty (Gosa Inspector on RR Trains*, in accordance with
General Order, No. 96, Adjutant and Inspector General's Office, Richmond, July 8th, 1863.

I hereby certify that I Lewis Brownson sold and delivered
to A. W. Slayback Ord Officer Greens Brig Mo Vols. on or about
the 20th day of August 1862 on behalf of the Confederate State
of America one (1) double barreled Shot Gun which was de-
appraised at \$20⁰⁰ Twenty Dollars. I also certify that said gun
was my own individual property and was used in the service
of the Confederate Army for Six (6) Months for other
time I am entitled for use of same one (1) Dollar a month.
Also that I have never received any pay whatever for said gun.
The said gun was turned over in pursuance of a "Quit Order"
dated about the 15th day of August 1862 & issued by Brig Gen
Little at Sactillo Miss. Said Order & records were lost
during the Siege of Vicksburg Miss.
